

Ohio County Employees Retirement Plan name change frequently asked questions



Q: Why is the CCAO Deferred Compensation Plan changing its name to OCERP?

A: The new plan name, Ohio County Employee Retirement Plan (OCERP) is meant to more clearly emphasize that the plan is available to all county employees throughout county government as an employee benefit to them and is an opportunity for them to prepare for the future they imagine in their retirement.

Q: Is CCAO changing its name or is it only the CCAO Deferred Compensation Plan name that is changing to Ohio County Employees Retirement Plan (OCERP)?

A: The County Commissioners Association of Ohio (CCAO) name is not changing.

Q: Are the forms that say CCAO Deferred Compensation still valid?

A: Yes, the name will be updated on the forms but in the meantime, you can still use a form that has the CCAO Deferred Compensation name on it. Current forms can be requested by calling the Empower Care Center at (800) 284-0444.

Q: Do I have a new Retirement Plan Advisor because of the plan name changing?

A: Empower does have two new Retirement Plan Advisors so please refer to the current representative assignments by [clicking here](#).

Q: Did the plan number change?

A: No, the OCERP plan number is still 340001-01.

Q: Did the 800 number change?

A: No, the number to the care center for OCERP remains (800) 284-0444.
