The Otterbein Advantage Scholarship is designed to support Delaware County employees and their spouse/domestic partner in their continued educational pursuits. Delaware County employees and their spouse/ domestic partner enrolling as part-time undergraduate or graduate students will receive a scholarship reducing cost per credit hour. Scholarship is valid for one undergraduate or graduate degree per student. Graduate Nursing degree(s) <u>not</u> included in this Scholarship.

Scholarship details:

- Be verified as a Delaware County employee and/or employee spouse/ domestic partner at the time of admission.
- Meet Otterbein admissibility criteria.
- Be registered for all classes for the term by August 1 for Fall semester, December 1 for Spring semester, or May 1 for Summer term, each year of enrollment.
- Maintain a 3.0 GPA in graduate course work. Maintain a 2.75 GPA in undergraduate course work.

Employee & Spouse/Domestic Partner Benefits:

• Up to 3 classes per semester, or 9 credit hours for undergraduate or graduate courses.

Discount:

• Students will receive a discount of 15% on the per credit hour charge for up to 9 credits per semester.



THE OTTERBEIN ADVANTAGE SCHOLARSHIP FOR DEPENDENTS OF DELAWARE COUNTY EMPLOYEES

The Otterbein Advantage Scholarship for dependents of Delaware County employees is available to any undergraduate prior to the age of 24 while still an IRS dependent and who has not completed a Bachelor's degree, whether they are applying as a **new** first-time first year student or a transfer student. Dependent children of employees currently enrolled at Otterbein are <u>NOT</u> eligible for this scholarship. The current value of this annual scholarship is **\$19,000**.

Scholarship details:

- Student must meet Otterbein admissibility criteria.
- Renewable for a total of 8 semesters of undergraduate enrollment, or first undergraduate degree, whichever is achieved first.
- Replaces all other Otterbein non-need-based scholarships or grants (need-based aid may still be available to eligible students).
- Students must enroll full-time each semester (12 hour minimum).
- Students enrolling for more than 18 hours per semester must pay for additional credits.
- Student must maintain a 2.75 GPA and make Satisfactory Academic Progress each term.
- Student must complete Advantage Partner section of common application or provide notice to Otterbein of desire to participate in the scholarship program at the time of application to be considered. Students will not be considered after the time of the admission.
- Student's parent or legal guardian must be an employee of Company at the time of admission.
